

Synopsis – Vernon Township Board Meeting (June 8, 2026)

The Vernon Township Board met on June 8, 2026, with three board members present.

Minutes from the May meeting were approved without changes.

The Fire Chief reported 20 total runs for the month, recent equipment upgrades, successful annual pump testing, and participation in local parades; the report was accepted by the board.

No meetings were held for the Zoning Board of Appeals or Planning Commission, and no building report was submitted. The Ambulance report was provided in the packet, and the Supervisor read the Sheriff's April and May incident totals (232 and 215 respectively). No clerk report was given as the clerk was absent.

During public comment, residents from Holiday Shores raised concerns about delays in resolving the bath house issue. The board noted a permit had been issued 10 days earlier, and the township attorney explained the option of appealing to the Construction Code Board of Appeals if disagreements persist.

Under Old Business, the board approved contracting Discount Tree for \$1,600 to remove a tree at Chalker Cemetery and authorized hiring a 12-hour-per-week assistant for building and planning.

Under New Business, all payroll and fund distributions were approved, and the board accepted a \$29,700 bid from Godfreys for a new roof on the Vernon Village Fire Hall.

The meeting adjourned at 7:52 p.m.
